2. Reply to the questions is as under:

In this context, it is informed that Startup India is not specific to Startups coming from any particular State. A number of facilities and incentives available under Startup India Initiative to all Startups irrespective of States may be summarized as below:-

- (i) Online recognition of Startups and Incubators.
- (ii) The Startup India Hub has been established for handholding support to Startups.
- (iii) Establishment of an Rs.10, 000 Crore Fund of Funds for Startups for providing financial support to Startups.
- (iv) Extending Tax incentives and IPR benefits to eligible Startups.
- (v) Establishment of National Credit Guarantee Scheme for Startups to encourage investors.
- (vi) Providing legal support and fast-tracking the patent examination along with rebate on fees for patent filing.
- (vii) Setting up of Incubators under Atal Innovation Mission.
- (viii) Setting up of Startup Centres and Technology Business Incubators at National institutes.
