**REGISTRATION PROCESS UNDER CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME FOR JAMMU  
AND KASHMIR**

**1334. SHRI MAHESH PODDAR:**

Will the **Minister of Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which the registration process for new units under the new Central Sector Scheme for industrial development of Jammu and Kashmir would be conducted;
- (b) the various type of projects to be set up/launched under the said scheme;
- (c) whether priority would be given to Private Public Partnership to provide project contracts under the said scheme; and
- (d) the estimated cumulative economic benefit and employment generation from the said scheme?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY  
(SHRI SOM PARKASH)**

- (a): Registration of units under the new Central Sector Scheme for industrial development of Jammu and Kashmir would be done through on-line portal.
- (b): The scheme is applicable for any industrial (manufacturing) entity or eligible service sector enterprise other than those run departmentally by Government, which is registered business enterprise under Goods and Service tax.
- (c): Applications of Private Public Partnership projects will be considered as per the eligibility.
- (d): The total financial outlay of the Scheme is Rs. 28,400 crore and estimated direct employment generation is anticipated to be nearly 78000 persons. However the scheme has potential to trigger much more gainful employment indirectly in Jammu and Kashmir and give unprecedented cumulative economic gains.

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
